FUND MANAGER'S COMMENTS

Amidst increasing evidence that the global economy is slowing down, we expect to see more central banks cutting rates. This dynamic should result in yields on the longer end of the yield curve coming down. As such, we are lengthening duration to 6.0 - 7.0 years while remaining invested in liquid papers.
