FUND MANAGER'S COMMENTS

MGS market continued its recovery in January, after a strong performance in December. This notwithstanding, we still see value as yields are still very much higher compared to pre-November 2016 levels. With increasing protectionism globally, there is greater downside risk to global growth. As such, we continue to expect global interest rates to be low. We also feel that the market may be overly optimistic regarding Trump growth-boosting policies. On the local front, 2017 will be a challenging year both on external and domestic side. We see Bank Negara taking the opportunity to cut the Overnight Policy Rate, should there be a period of stability for the Ringgit, to boost domestic consumption. Therefore, our strategy is to remain with a duration of around 6 years, while keeping the portfolio invested in higher grade and more liquid papers. We also note that credit conditions could deteriorate in a prolonged slow growth environment, which is why we prefer higher grade rated sukuk that have stronger financial standing.
